





- 1. Palazzo is a collection of mosaics from New Ravenna. The 13 patterns are handcrafted in Virginia from natural stone and explore the classic motifs used in Italian palaces of the Renaissance era. Each pattern can be fully customized with material preferences and used in outdoor and indoor applications. newravenna.com
- 2. Eagle by Woodlabo is a collection of five lights inspired by the Eagle Lunar Module. Orbit, Landing, Moon, and Lift Off are combinations of two or three modules and represent the mission's four stages. The birch plywood panels are spaced a few millimeters apart, letting through light to accentuate its outline. woodlabo.com
