JOURNEY THROUGH TIME

SASHA BIKOFF AND NEW RAVENNA INTRODUCE AN INSPIRED TIME-TRAVELING TEXTILE COLLECTION. BY CLAIRE HARPER

New Ravenna's New World collection by interior design guru—and Hamptons' own—Sasha Bikoff features seven handcrafted designs inspired by her vision to create the undeniably American textile. "Every time I would travel to some exotic place I noticed the tiles were a representation of the country, but as Americans we don't really have that," says the veteran designer. Inspired by the concept of discovering the New World, the first mosaic, Atlas Maior, is an enchanting rendition of baroque geography interpreted from 17th century Dutch cartography.

(Bikoff plans to display the colorful stone in her sprawling new Hamptons home under construction on Gardiners Bay.) Also influenced by the concept of discovery is Ptolemy's Cosmos, a map illustrating the universe from terrestrial to celestial to astrological. When it came to identifying the quintessential American design, Bikoff sought to find textiles that embody the country's iconic culture. What came of it were the East Coast and West Coast designs, two water jet stone mosaics donning vintage bandanna patterns (does it get more American than that?) as well as three delicate and feminine lace creations influenced by the intricacy of antique lace. "I wanted textiles that would be good representations [of America] and could also transform into surfaces in a whimsical way," shares Bikoff. Created to outfit walls and floors both inside and out, these stunning mosaic stones are just the summer revamp your Hamptons abode craves. *Blackman Plumbing Supply,*
